Dear Parents and Carers.

As outlined in recent newsletters, we are looking forward to various upcoming Christmas events, details of which are outlined below.

EYFS and KS1 Nativities

Our Early Years and KS1 classes are about to start practising for their nativities this year! More information will be sent home in the coming weeks regarding costumes and things that you can do at home. Where we do ask pupils to provide elements of costumes, we will keep this as simple as possible. Please see performance times below.

Key Stage 1 (Years 1 & 2): Wed 13th Dec – 9.15am

Thurs 14th Dec - 2.30pm

Early Years (Nursery & Reception): Wed 13th Dec – 11.15am

How to book: although tickets are free of charge, they will need to be booked on Arbor 'School Shop'. Bookings will open at 7pm on Thursday, 16th November and tickets are available on a first-come-first-served basis. Please note that once you have purchased tickets, you will not receive a confirmation email, but rather you will be able to log into your child's Arbor account to view confirmation that your ticket(s) have been booked. Due to fire regulations, there is a maximum limit of three tickets per family per performance in the first instance. If there are still tickets available after 5th December, we will open these up to anyone else who wishes to attend.

On the day: please wait at the gate to the front playground, from where you will be shown into the back of the school hall. If your child usually has PE on their performance day, they can come to school in their PE kit as usual.

Events in the Run up To Christmas

Community – As we approach Christmas, it is always a good opportunity to engage with our community and our children will be taking part in a number of events, including carol singing in the community and working with the retirement home. This year, we will also be offering a 'grandparent afternoon' on Tuesday, 12th December for any of our older members of the community to come and hear some carols, play some games and have a mince pie or two!

Following the success of this last year, our older pupils will also be asking for donations of small Christmas goodies (such as a box of mince pies or a sweet treat) which will be used to create some small packs which will be given to those in our local community to show support or thanks for the work that they do. To achieve this, we would like to ask if, during the week of Monday 4th December, you would be able to donate something which the children can use to make these parcels.

Nominate for an Xmas Gift - we would also welcome nominations of anyone in the local community (elderly neighbours, grandparents etc.) who you feel would benefit from a Christmas gift! Christmas Week

Within school, we will have a number of different events leading up to Christmas. Tuesday, 19th December

- Carols Around the Tree Parents and carers are invited to join us for a whole-school Carol service at 9.00am.
- Christmas Lunch —We are looking forward to bringing all the classes together in the hall for Christmas Lunch. A google form will be sent out to you w/c 20th November so that you can place your child's Christmas lunch order (orders must be placed no later than Thursday 30th November). Nursery parents; Following feedback from parents last year, we are also inviting Nursery children to join in with Christmas Lunch between 12pm and 1pm. There will be a £2,53 per child cost for this.

Wednesday 20th December

- **Church Visit** We will be walking to church for our Christmas Service today and will be back at school mid-morning. This service is for pupils only.
- End of the day Please note that term ends at 1.30pm for all pupils.

Following the Christmas holidays, school will reopen for all pupils on Thursday 4th January at the normal time. All term dates are on our school website.
