### Science Experiment

Do you know what floats and what sinks? Fill a washing up bowl/bucket with water and gather together some healthy foods, like apples, carrots, bananas, melon, oranges, lemons, strawberries etc. Can you predict what sinks or floats? Draw some pictures of your healthy food and tell me what it did in the water. Then you can have a go at apple bobbing! Enjoy!

### Art & Design

Tell us all about yourself! Using this sheet provided, what do you like to do best? Sweet/sour? Hot/cold? Colour in the object in each box that you prefer as carefully as you can and stick it into your homework book.

### Maths

This term, we will be looking at subitising. Try this activity; this game needs 2 people, each with a dice. Throw the dice together. Can your child tell you instantly how many dots on their dice? (They may start with counting, which is fine.) Who has more? Who has less? Play the game for 10 rounds and use your homework book to mark down the scores.



### RE



In RE this term, we are going to be thinking about people that we think are special. We will talk about what a role model is and think about the qualities this person might have that we admire. Draw a picture of your role model in your homework book and tell me who they are and which quality they have that you particularly like.

### Understanding the World

We will spend some time thinking about our bodies this half term and what each part of our body does. Find a doll, Barbie or superhero toy and use the doll to talk about the different body parts - point out each bit and ask what it is called. Then pose questions like "What do we use our ears for?" and "How would we walk if we didn't have legs?" etc. Take a photo of the doll and put it in your homework book.

### Personal Development



Do you tidy your toys away at home? At school, we will learn to join in with tidy up time. We will work as a team to make sure our classroom stays neat and tidy. Can you start at home by making sure you tidy away your toys as you play? Take a photo of you tidying and stick in in your homework book.

### Maths

In maths, we will be learning to count to 10, making sure we count each object correctly and in the right order. Can you count things as you move around your house? How many windows do you have? How many stairs are in your house? How many people sit at the table for dinner? How many plates/bowls/knives/forks do you use? Draw a picture of your house and, using your counting skills, tell me how many things you have in your home.

### Reading

This half term, we will be reading wordless books. Each book will tell a story through pictures. This is to encourage conversation and storytelling. Please spend time with your child as often as you can to go through your book and then write in your child's reading record, telling us if they understood the story.
