Science experiment

Have a go at the 'Coke Super Fountain' experiment.

Understanding the world



We had storm Eunice and Storm Dudley over half term. Discuss with your child what types of weather make a storm. Then talk to your child about the four seasons. What type of weather is featured in each season? Draw a picture of our four seasons in your book and have a go at writing the words, listening to the sounds and using your knowledge of phonics.

Maths

We have been talking about the order of the numbers 1-20 in Maths. Click on the link below and have a look at 'Bud's Number Garden'. The game asks children to place the numerals in the right order. 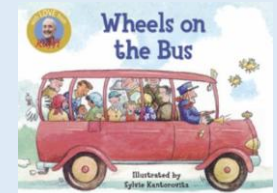
RE

Music

Listen to and sing your favourite nursery song. The list of songs is endless but could include songs like Tommy Thumb, The Wheels on the Bus, Miss Polly had a dolly, Baa Baa Black Sheep, Polly put the kettle on etc. Then draw a picture in your home learning book about the song.



Personal Development

Can you be a superhero helper and help your parent/carer set the dinner table? Where is your cutlery draw? What cutlery will you need? What about plates or bowls? After dinner, try clearing the table and taking things to be washed up. Take a Superhero photo and post it on Evidence Me.



Art & Design

Our topic this term is Superheroes. We have been thinking about what powers Superheroes have and the costumes they wear. Can you design a new Superhero costume in your home learning book? What special abilities does your Superhero have? What colours would your costume have to reflect these powers?



Maths

We have been looking at the order of the numbers from 1-10 this term. We have looked at towers and noted where each one is on the number line, increasing or decreasing by one every time. Play this robot game, which will help deepen the understanding of this concept.
