








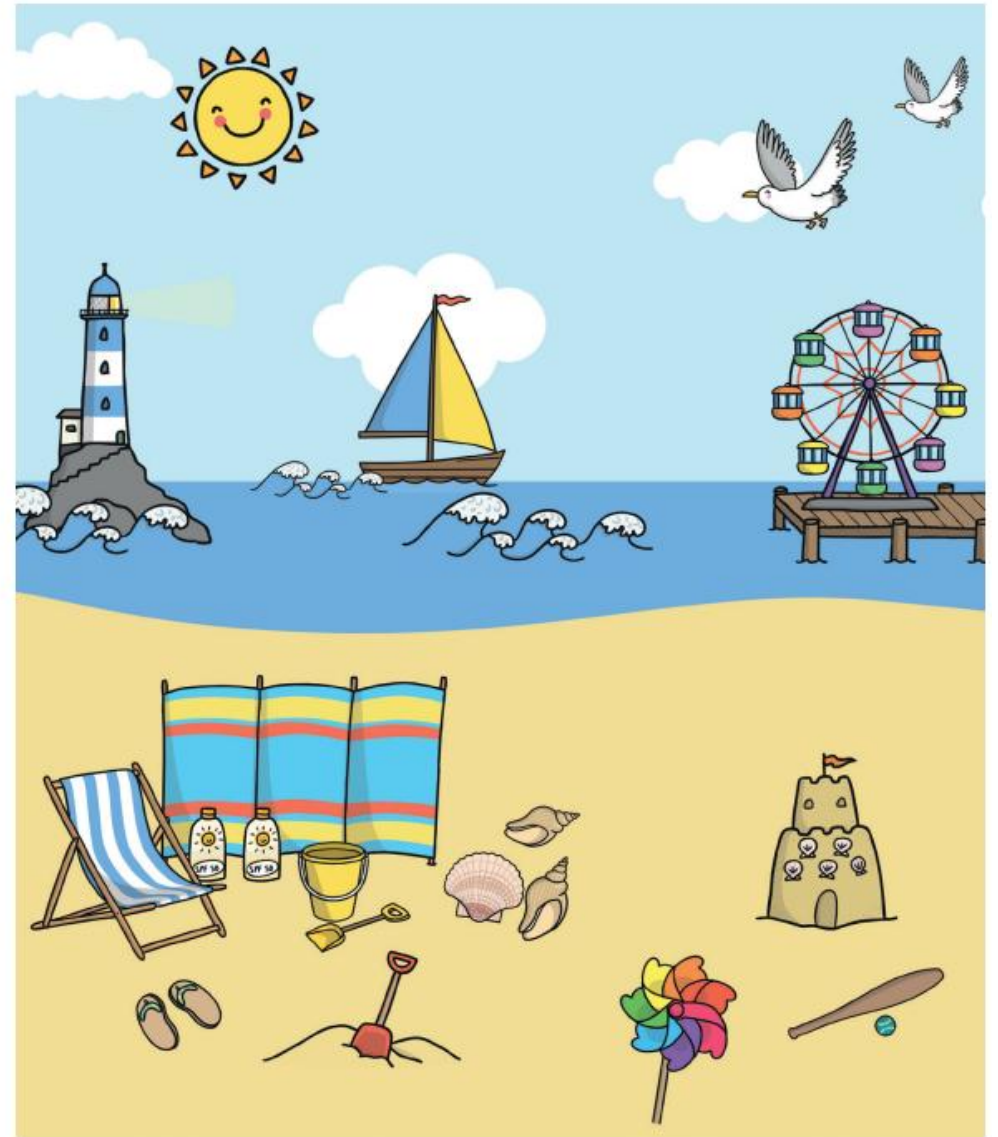
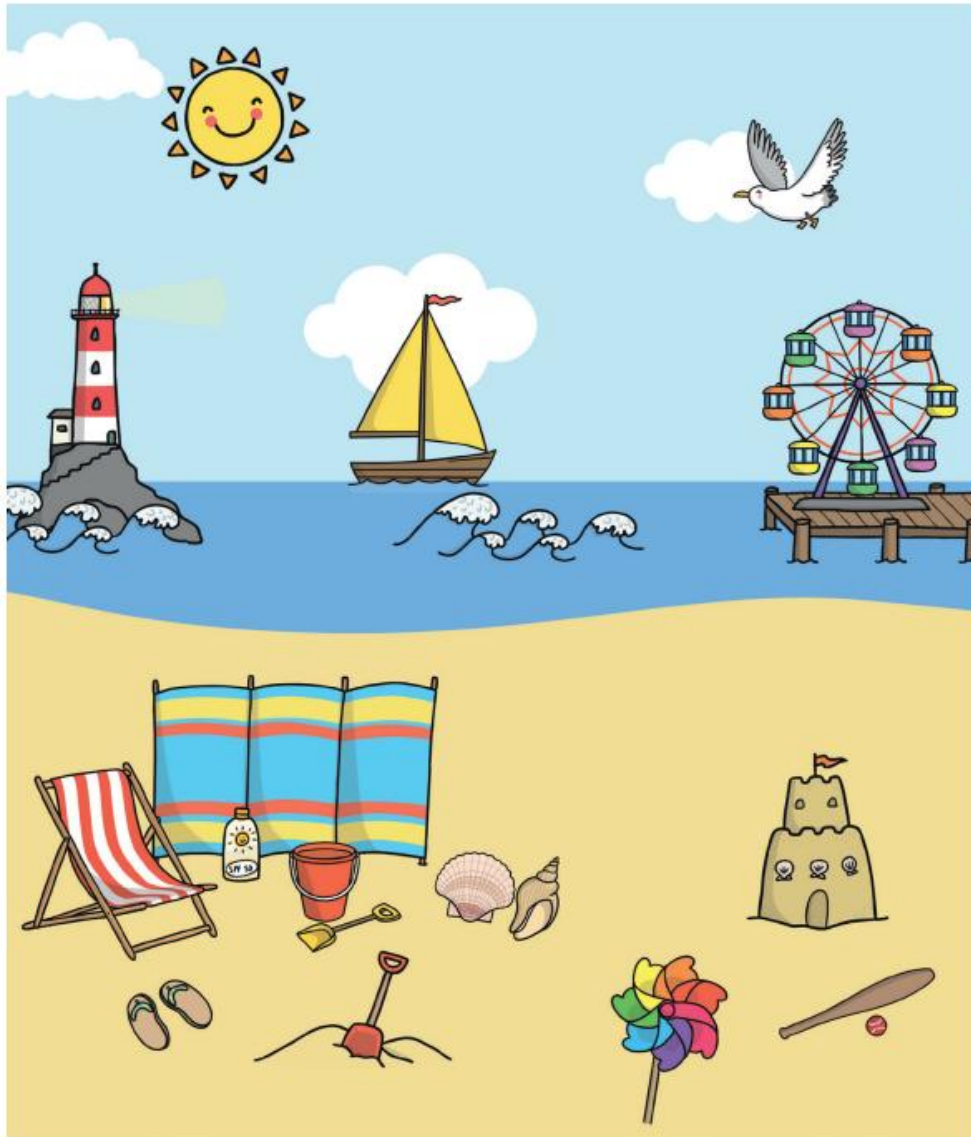


Year R's Homework Menu - Summer 2nd Half Term

|  <p>Science Experiment You need 2 cups of water, two large daisies and two different types of food colouring. Place a teaspoon of food colouring into each glass with some water. Chop the end of the stem off the daisies and place them into the water. Then watch over the next few hours. Write down what and why you think it happens in your homework book or post a photo on Evidence Me.</p> |  <p>Communication & Language Seaside spot the difference. Have a look at the seaside pictures provided. Talk about what you can see. You could talk about the noises you might hear at the seaside, or the feeling of the sand, sea, sun on your skin. When did you go to the seaside? What did you do? There are 6 differences between the two pictures. Can you spot them? Circle the differences and stick them in your homework book.</p> | <p>Communication & Language Listen to this poem by Robert Louis Stevenson https://www.youtube.com/watch?v=fUuGV-JvHXw Talk about what the shadow does in the poem. Go into the garden on a sunny day and find your shadow. What happens when you move around? Can you make your shadow shorter or longer? How can you make it disappear? Find an object that you can draw around and stick it into your homework book.</p>  |
| <p>Maths This term, we will be looking at doubling and halving. Have a go at this activity. Take 5-10 small objects and place them in front of a mirror. Explain that when we double, we add the same number again. Count all of the objects (in front of the mirror as well as in the mirror.) Write down five number sentences in your homework book.</p>  | <p>RE In RE this term, we are going to be thinking about places that are special. We will consider houses of worship from the Christian, Islamic Jewish faiths. Can you tell me where your 'special place' is? It could be your bedroom, a place in the park, a special holiday destination etc. Draw a picture of it and tell me why it's special in your homework book.</p>  | <p>Understanding the World Watch this video about looking after our planet. Reflect on what you have seen and heard. Discuss with your child what the problems are. Try and think of ways you can change what your family does in response to this - how can you help? Write one of your ideas down in your homework book.</p>  |
| <p>Personal Development Do you help out at home? Who tidies your bedroom? Have you ever used the Hoover at home? Why don't you Hoover your bedroom? Send me a photo on Evidence Me</p>  | <p>Art & Design Make a natural colour collage. You will need to gather some natural materials. (flowers, grasses, weeds etc). Find a piece of card and place some glue or some double-sided sticky tape onto it. Then arrange your natural objects onto the card into a nice pattern. Take a photo and load it onto Evidence Me.</p>  | <p>Reading Spend some time reading the red and green words that are in your book bag. How fast can you read the words? Set yourself a challenge: time how long it takes to read them from cover to cover. Then read the words again 10 times. Time yourself again. Did you get any faster? Upload a video onto Evidence Me.</p>  |
