





## Year 2's Homework Menu - Autumn 2<sup>nd</sup> Half Term

<p style="text-align: center;"><b>English</b></p> <p>If you could do something amazing for a day; what would it be?</p> <p>You could be an astronaut and fly a rocket into space, you could be a superhero and have special powers, you could meet someone famous! Write about your most amazing day ever!</p>	<p style="text-align: center;"><b>Maths</b></p> <p>Learn your 2, 5, and 10 times tables.</p> <p>You can use equipment to help you. You need to be able to recall the number sentence and the answer really quickly!</p>	<p style="text-align: center;"><b>Science</b></p> <p>In science, we will be looking at life cycles. Research a lifecycle of your choice and draw a picture to explain it.</p> 
<p style="text-align: center;"><b>Maths</b></p> <p>Using a variety of coins make different amounts. Record these in your book.</p> <p>Have a go at playing shops and work out how much money you will need to buy 2 items and then work out change from a £1 or £2 coin.</p> 	<p style="text-align: center;"><b>RE</b></p> <p>This term we are focusing on The Gospel and thinking about the question 'What is the good news Jesus brings?'</p> <p>Retell the story of The Good Samaritan- you could write the story or draw a story board. Then explain what it teaches us.</p>	<p style="text-align: center;"><b>PE</b></p> <p>Time yourself doing 50 star jumps. Do this every day for a week and see if your time gets better.</p> <p>You can try this with any activity. What happens to your time? Why do you think you get faster or slower?</p>
<p style="text-align: center;"><b>Art</b></p> <p>Using value (tone) choose one pencil to colour a picture. You can make the colour lighter by pressing lightly and darker by pressing really hard.</p> 	<p style="text-align: center;"><b>English</b></p>  <p>I would like you to read every day. This can be your school book, a book from home or helping to read a recipe or shopping list. Record in your reading record every day what you have read.</p>	<p style="text-align: center;"><b>Maths</b></p> <p>Write these numbers in words. For example: 20 = twenty</p> <p style="text-align: right;">47 38 94 121 132</p>
