<p style="text-align: center;">English</p> <p>Write a detailed description of a character from a book. Would you describe this character to a friend as either good or bad? How do you know that they are either good or bad? Think about how they actually speak, the words used and their actions and behaviour.</p> 	<p style="text-align: center;">Maths</p> <p>If you are able to, use pieces of Lego or similar. First, count out 12 pieces. Then see how many equal groups you can make without having any pieces left over. Example: 12 can have 4 equal groups of 3 pieces or 3 equal groups of 4. What else? Try a larger number if you have enough pieces.</p> <div style="border: 1px solid black; padding: 5px; text-align: center; background-color: #e0e0e0;"> <p>26 22 28 24 18 36 20 32 12</p> </div>	<p style="text-align: center;">Science</p> <p>In science, we will be exploring plants. Use the Plant and Flower Hunt Sheet to explore plants and flowers in your garden, local park or whilst on a walk along the canal maybe. Everyone can get involved, working together or as a fun race. See how many you can find.</p> 
<p style="text-align: center;">Maths</p> <p>We have been learning to use division by sharing. Ask children to help you share things out amongst people, such as sweets or roast potatoes! Discuss how many you have and how many people need a share. Discuss how many each person could have equally, are there any leftover, the remainder?</p>	<p style="text-align: center;">RE</p> <p>In RE, we are thinking about what places give us a sense of belonging. Our topic is Thinking about 'Does going to the Mosque give Muslims a sense of belonging?' Draw and label a picture of a place where you feel you belong. It could be your home, your bedroom, a place of worship or even a club you belong to.</p>	<p style="text-align: center;">English</p> <div style="display: flex; align-items: center;">  <div style="margin-left: 10px;"> <p>Investigate homophones. These are words which are spelt differently but sound the same. How many can you find? Make a list and write the different meanings of the words.</p> </div> </div>
<p style="text-align: center;">Personal Development</p>  <p>Take some time to think... Find a place where you feel comfortable, maybe in your bedroom or outside in a garden. Think about those people around you, family and friends that look after you and are kind to you. Perhaps you could make a card for them.</p>	<p style="text-align: center;">English</p> <div style="text-align: center;">  </div> <p>Choose a word, this can be taken from a book. Then see how many other words you can correctly spell using only these letters.</p>	<p style="text-align: center;">Maths</p> <p>Write out your 2, 5 and 10 times table. Then if you want a challenge write out the inverse, the division Maths sentence. Example: $5 \times 5 = 25$ Inverse: $25 \div 5 = 5$ Can you see a connection?</p>
