









Year 1's Homework Menu - Autumn 1st Half Term

<p>English</p> <p>Draw a picture of something you like to do and write a sentence telling me about it. Make sure you use a capital letter to start the sentence and a full stop at the end.</p> 	<p>Maths</p> <p>Draw a bush in the middle of a piece of paper. Draw a lion next to the bush, a mouse underneath the bush, and a cheetah in front of the bush. Draw a zebra behind the bush (you might just be able to see his tail poking out) and a parrot on top of the bush.</p>  <p>Try following the instructions which use prepositional language!</p>	<p>Science</p> <p>The Four Seasons.</p> <p>Do you know what a season is? What season has just begun? Find out about the four seasons and what the weather is like for each one.</p> 
<p>Maths</p> <p>Learning number patterns. Play some dice games (like snakes and ladders) or Dominoes. Learn the dot patterns for each number.</p> 	<p>RE</p> <p>In RE, we are learning about how the Jewish celebration of Rosh Hashanah. Find more about the celebration: I wonder if you can find out what special food is eaten for this celebration and why?</p> 	<p>English</p> <p>We will be learning about foods and where they come from this term. When you go shopping look for where your fruit has been grown. You could then try to find the place on a world map.</p> 
<p>Personal Development</p>  <p>This terms PSHE is all about being me. Tell me one thing you are good at and one thing you think you would like to improve in Year 1.</p>	<p>English</p> <p>Read your favourite story. Draw a picture of your favourite character and describe them. What's their name? What do they look like? Describe their personality.</p> 	<p>Maths</p> <p>Ask your grown-up to tell you a number. Place this number of raisins or cereal pieces on your plate. If your grown-up says 'one more', can you add one more and say the number you have? If your grown-up says 'one less', can you eat one then count the number you have left?</p>
